## Construction

**1.1** The Lyndeborough pricing and design is an ongoing item.

(6/19) Tim sent out the layout & plan. The plan needs to be discussed at the next meeting before work is ordered.

Tim wants to make note that the gate of the fence needs a child safety lock on it.

**3.1** Kyle mentioned that the kitchen may need expanding. It will require a commercial kitchen hood. The plan is to use the existing hood from FRES and get a new hood for the FRES kitchen. Hutter to price.

- **4.2** The flooring for the tile in the hallway has come back with asbestos. They will test the rest of the school Thursday when the kids are gone. The permit has been filed. So the 10 day waiting period has started.
- (6/19) The second round of testing found that it was only the mastic that has asbestos. It was determined that the SAU would get the carpet tile, the classroom tile would remain in place and the hallway would receive carpet tiles.
- (6/26) As of now, the plan is to leave the existing hallway as it is. The school will inform the team if this plan changes.
- **5.2** The Fire Chief is cautious about starting work prior to getting approval from the State Fire Marshal. Kyle to review.

Hutter to also fill out all the paperwork required to get the permit from the town.

- (6/19) Paperwork has been filed with the town. They have issued a demolition permit. The school will meet to make a decision if the construction can move forward without final sign off from the State.
- (6/26) The building plans will be reviewed by the town over the weekend. If there are no issues, they will issue a permit Monday morning.
